I am looking for information regarding funding provided to the Whithorn Trust which we believe to be of the amount of £220,000 for the Old Town Hall in Whithorn?
Could you assist us in finding the funding information on your website.

All SOSE grant awards are published on our [website](#).

SOSE has not provided The Whithorn Trust with £220,000 for the Old Town Hall in Whithorn so we are unable to direct you to information on our website.

SOSE provided one funding grant to The Whithorn Trust in Quarter 1 2021/22 (April – June 2021) and it is published on the SOSE [website](#). The award was for £6,636 for financial support towards two separate feasibility pieces of work :

- New Museum in Whithorn
- The Whithorn Way, a 147-mile long distance walking/cycling route following Whithorn's westerly mediaeval pilgrimage route.
